Wijkasteel Haksberg – Carduela | Belgische wijn | Pinot Noir–Dornfelder Belgium (België) – 2023

Domain

Wijkasteel Haksberg

Wijkasteel Haksberg is an extensive domain of woodland and parkland in the Hageland, with a small castle from the 19th century, a wine terrace, rolling vineyards and good Belgian wine. The wines have recently won awards in the low countries and are therefore better known. The name of the wines always refers to (the Latin name of) a bird that has been spotted on the domain. The vineyard has traditional grape varieties such as Dornfelder, Auxerrois, Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. They work according to the principle of integrated crop protection.

Vinification

The harvest is carried out manually, as this guarantees better quality grapes. The wine is fermented at a low temperature, which slows down the process and allows more time for the development of aromas and aromatic compounds. The wine matures from October to May.

Taste

Carduela is a full-bodied, complex red wine. It has a rich, fruity nose with aromas of blackberry and elderberry, complemented by notes of cherry and blueberry.
