

Wijnfiche Montaubert – Cognac 1953 COGNAC – 1953

Domain Montaubert

The Albert de Montaubert family distillery at Vallein Tercinier is the oldest Cognac distillery still (pun intended) in production. They harvest from their own estate vineyards located in the heart of the Cognac region. This real-estate is critical. This small exclusive area, or "cru", is where Cognac's finest grapes are produced and given the "appellation" Grande Champagne. The family purchased these vineyards in 1791.

Vinification

The Imperial Vintage Cognac Selection is an exclusive collection of exceptionally great Cognac from 1950 to 1990. Each bottle contains Cognac taken exclusively from one vintage in the barrels, where the brandy gradually matures. Even the annual loss of the "Angles' share" is replaced by spirit from the same year, thus guaranteeing a 100% vintage Cognac from each year.
