## **Machrie Moor – Island Single Malt Whisky – 56.2% CS | Peated WHISKY –**

### **Domain**

#### **Arran**

Production began at our first distillery in beautiful Lochranza almost 30 years ago. Many other locations were considered at the time, but the proximity to Loch na Davie provided us with a rather special source of fresh water for distilling. We knew this would hold us in good stead in the years to come. Our second distillery opened in the south of the island in 2019 at Lagg, where we make a very unique style of peated single malt.

### **Vinification**

On the west coast of the Isla of Arran lies a windswept and mystical peat bog called Machrie Moor. Bronze Age stone circles and standing stones are strewn across its barren, undulating terrain. One of the stone circles is known as Fingal's Cauldron Seat, where sits a stone with a carved hole. The legendary warrior giant Fingal is said to have tethered his favourite dog Bran to this stone. This cask strength peated expression of the Arran Single Malt perfectly captures the rugged beauty and lore of the landscape. Unleash the legend that is Machrie Moor. Bottled at 56.2% vol. without chill filtration or added colouring.

### **Taste**

Citrus notes with a background of peat and a puff of smoke immediately apparent. A robust dram with the typical orchard fruits of Arran coming to the fore over a layer of toasted brioche and red berries. Finish with citrus, smoke, chocolate, vanilla and coconut.
