



Domaine Gerard Fiou Rouge | Sancerre France (LOIRE) — 2019

Domain

Domaine Gérard Fiou is a historic domain located in the Sancerre AOP, located in Saint-Satur, a small village. Domaine Gérard Fiou is a private family estate that was founded by the ancestors of Gérard Fiou. Today, the wine estate, 10 hectares in size and with 100% silex substrate, is entirely in the hands of the Bourgeois family.

Vinification

The grapes are carefully selected from vines older than 60 years, planted on a South West oriented slope, rich in clay and pebbles. Alcoholic fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks, for 12 days and at 29 ° C. For optimum extraction, stirring and transferring takes place twice a day. Aging in large oak barrels, which makes the wine full and round, with a small vanilla touch.

Taste

The wine has a ruby red to garnet red color. He develops aronmas from very ripe red fruit, berries and plums, with a slight touch of vanilla. In the mouth this red Sancerre is powerful and remarkably full. The taste is concentrated and structured, which indicates a nice storage potential.
