



Ehrhart - Pfohl - Jade | Alsace Riesling | BIO | France (ALSACE) — 2023

Domain

Ehrhart

The vineyards of the Ehrhart André family are located in Wettolsheim province, situated between the castles of Eguisheim and Hohlandsbourg. One has an area of more than 10 hectares of 'Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée' including four hectares in 'Appellation Grands Crus'.

Vinification

Alluvial terroir of the Fecht alluvial cone located on the banks of Turckheim. The sandy alluvium is rich in clay (22%) and devoid of limestone. These alluvial-siliceous soils outcrop and are locally covered with deposits or loess silt.

Taste

The bright nose of orange blossom and freshly squeezed lemon juice features subtle herbaceous notes, including basil. Quite dry with a fairly generous structure, it has good concentration and some textural complexity carefully wrapped around the lively acidity. Long and complex finish with lots of minerality.
