Château Pichon Baron, Second Grand Cru Classé in 1855, is one of the historic vineyards of Bordeaux. Pauillac, one of the appellations of the Bordeaux Médoc vineyard, is located about forty kilometers north of Bordeaux on the left bank of the Gironde.

Château Pichon Baron with its two emblematic turrets, of incomparable romanticism and charm, sits enthroned in the heart of the vineyard.

A rigorous selection policy, in the vineyard and in the cellars, guarantees the development of the Grand Vin, Château Pichon Baron, which represents the pure expression of this unique terroir.

This authentic Pauillac offers an intense sensory discovery of black fruits and spicy notes.

Château Pichon Baron reflects elegance, power and exceptional length in the mouth. It improves year after year and can age for more than 40 years in the cellar.

Vinification

Matured for 80% in new barrels, 20% in barrels of one vintage for 18 months

Taste

Château Pichon Baron 2018 reveals a dark garnet colour. The precise and delicate nose offers notes of fresh fruit, black berries and spices. The attack is mellow, generous, rounded and juicy, developing powerful, wellblended tannins. The body is structured with silky, racy tannins. The flavour is carried by the structure, which preserves the mid-palate. The finish is tasty, full, fleshy, and harmonious. The richness is perfectly integrated and the style is highly characteristic, built to last through the decades, while retaining elegance and distinction
