

**Château Le Prieuré – G.C.C. | St.

Ch. Le Prieuré

The domain was founded in 1832, when it was led by Baron Olivier Guichard, a man with a great political past. In 2004 it was taken over by the sixth generation of the family. Since then, daughter Aline and her husband Paul Goldschmidt have been at the helm. The vineyards cover an area of 6.24 hectares on a lime-rich surface and are oriented directly to the south. These are subdivided into 19 plots.

Vinification

The vines have an average age of 45 years and grow on chalky soil. The vineyard covers 6.24 hectares and the yield of the grapes is 49 hl/ha. After harvesting, the wine is vinified biodynamically and aged in wooden barrels (40% new, 50% second use and 10% third passage). Total production of 14000 bottles.

Taste

Complex and intense bouquet on the nose. Full and fresh attack on the palate with a persistent finish. A St.-Emilion with great potential!
