

**Domaine Rolet – 62 cl | Arbois Vin
Jaune
France (JURA) – 2016**

Domain

Dom. Rolet

The Rolet domain was established in the early 40s by Désiré Rolet. It is the second largest domain in the Jura region. This domain is 60 hectares and consists of three appellations: 36% Arbois, 21% Côtes du Jura and 43% L'étoile that contain five different grape varieties: Chardonnay, Savagnin, Poulsard, Trousseau and Pinot noir. The vineyards of the Jura are on clayey slopes, covered with marl and gravel.

Vinification

Manual harvesting and sorting Late grape variety, it is harvested manually at the end of the harvest to the maximum of its maturity. Under-veil ageing of 6 years and 3 months minimum in oak barrels.

Taste

Light yellow color with golden hues. After years of evolution, this intense golden yellow color. Balanced in the nose, with aromas of nuts, dried fruit, almonds and herbs. In the mouth the dried fruit, roasted with an infinite finale. Wine of the oxidative type with many aromas.
