

**Domaine Rolet – Poulsard – Vieilles
Vignes | Arbois
France (JURA) – 2022**

Domain

Dom. Rolet

The Rolet domain was established in the early 40s by Désiré Rolet. It is the second largest domain in the Jura region. This domain is 60 hectares and consists of three appellations: 36% Arbois, 21% Côtes du Jura and 43% L'étoile that contain five different grape varieties: Chardonnay, Savagnin, Poulsard, Trousseau and Pinot noir. The vineyards of the Jura are on clayey slopes, covered with marl and gravel.

Vinification

The harvest is done manually, with a maximum ripening of the grapes. Maturation: the Poulsard is one of the oldest specific varieties of the Jura. The wine undergoes a preferential cold fermentation of 8 days and a fermentation of a week. Ageing in cuves for 12 months.

Taste

Clear, characteristic of the Poulsard in the nose: red fruit and strawberries in the nose. On the palate: a good balance between tannins and a bit of liveliness, aromas of red fruits with a little spiciness.
