

## **Domaine Rolet – Rouge Tradition | Arbois France (JURA) – 2018**

### **Domain**

#### **Dom. Rolet**

The Rolet domain was established in the early 40s by Désiré Rolet. It is the second largest domain in the Jura region. This domain is 60 hectares and consists of three appellations: 36% Arbois, 21% Côtes du Jura and 43% L'étoile that contain five different grape varieties: Chardonnay, Savagnin, Poulsard, Trousseau and Pinot noir. The vineyards of the Jura are on clayey slopes, covered with marl and gravel.

### **Vinification**

Manual harvest and sorting. All varieties are vinified and matured separately for 12 months to preserve the character of each grape variety. The assembly is then done and the bottles are kept for 2 months before hitting the market.

### **Taste**

Ruby red color. Aromas of red fruit noticeable in the first nose, after which they evolve into spices, pepper and leather. Full and smooth in the mouth with well-integrated tannins.
