Château du Glana C.B. | St.-Julien France (SAINT-JULIEN) —

Domain

Ch. du Glana

In 1961 Mr. Meffre buys the Château du Glana and in the following years it expands from a domain of 5 hectares to a domain of 43.67 hectares. Of these 43 hectares, 67% of the vines, which are on average 21 years old, consist of Cabernet Sauvignon, 27% of Merlot and 6% of Cabernet Franc.

Vinification

This wine ages 12 months on French oak, 40% of which are new barriques.

Taste

Deep garnet red color. Blackberry nose, cassis mixed with Northern cherries. Soft attack, mouth filling, with lots of fruit and rounded tannins.

Skewers | Lamb | Mushroom | Steak
