Château Trotanoy | Pomerol France (POMEROL) — 2019

Château Trotanoy is located in Libourne, Pomerol one kilometer west of Pétrus. The winery first had the name "Trop Ennuie" and was owned by the Girauds family. This family changed the name to "Trotanoy" and since 1953 the winery is owned by Jean-Pierre Moueix. The winery has around 12 hectares of vineyard and produces 42,000 bottles annually.

Vinification

Grapes are picked by hand and after destemming, the juice is vinified in inox and concrete tanks. Wine stays in wooden barrels for 16 - 18 months, from which 50% new oak.

Taste

Trotanoy is among the most complex, concentrated and opulent Pomerols. From its deep dark colour, over its powerful nose, to the varied flavour sensations (blueberries and chocolate), Trotanoy indulges all our senses. What class!
