The Château Peyredon Lagravette is located in the Haut Médoc, and is enclosed by prestigious neighbors such as Poujeaux and Chasse Spleen. The estate has 4.2 ha and is therefore the smallest domain in the Haut Médoc.

Vinification

Harvested in crates all at once and then cold-pressed, the parcel-by-parcel vinification takes place in amphorae. Maturation: To enhance fruit integrity and purity, it is aged for 6 months in amphorae for greater respect of the fruit and purity.

Taste

Clear bright colour, it reveals subtle and delicate aromas. In mouth you feel note of citrus and exotic fruit of nice freshness and complexity. Finishing smooth and long with building minerality
