Domaine de l'Idylle - Vieille Vigne de Cruet | Jacquère Savoie France (SAVOIE) – 2024

Domain

Dom. de l'Idylle

This is a family domain, 22 hectares in size. They mainly produce wines from local grapes, Mondeuse, Roussette and Jacquère. Their southeastern slopes consist of clay and limestone gravel, where the grapes find their favorite terroir. They are certified with the High Environmental Value (HVE), which confirms the efforts they have been making since a few years to drastically reduce the supply to the vineyard and the cellar, as well as respect for our soil and biodiversity.

Vinification

With an average age of 80 years, these vines can certainly be described as old vines. After selecting the best grapes, gentle pressing, and alcoholic fermentation, the wine is aged on its lees. This is done partly in oak barriques, with the remainder in stainless steel tanks. The two components are then blended and bottled with an emphasis on freshness.

Taste

This white wine from Savoie, sourced from old vineyards in Cruet, displays a bright, pale straw-yellow color. On the nose, it opens with subtle aromas of ripe fruit such as pear and grapefruit, complemented by notes of fresh butter and gentle spices, creating a pleasing aromatic complexity.

On the palate, the attack is fresh and direct, the wine is full and supple. Flavors of fresh almond and citrus fill the palate, beautifully balanced by a lively acidity that preserves its freshness.
