Domain

Tenuta Carretta

This domain has been owned by the Miroglio family since 1985 and also owns an industrial textile group.

Its surface covers 65 hectares and is part of an exceptional area declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The family also owns 2.6 hectares of vineyards on the prestigious Cannubi Hill (Barolo).

The name Carretta is derived from the word "car", which means stone. This has ensured that the name Carretta was given to the nearby chalk bank that lies on the surface near the entrance and extends no less than a kilometer far to the east.

Vinification

This wine ages 6 months in stainless steel barrels. After the alcoholic fermentation, this wine remains in contact with its sediment for a short time to increase the complexity as well as the aromatic quality. Depending on the quality of the harvest year, he stays in contact with his grape skins for a shorter or longer period. Once the wine is cleared, it is bottled. After just a few weeks, the wine is ready for consumption.

Taste

Golden yellow color with green reflections. Aromas of pear, melon and white peach, both in the nose and in the mouth. The taste is round and fruity, with a fresh final.
