Vini Menhir – Calamuri | Salento IGT Italy (PUGLIA) – 2022

Domain

Vini Menhir

The wines of Vini Menhir come from Puglia in the heel of the boot of Italy. The vineyards are located in Basso Salento (province of Lecce) and in Alto Salento (province of Taranto-Brindisi). By planting different grape varieties in different wine regions, it is possible to produce a number of different types of wine here. The amount of grapes per hectare is limited and all grapes are harvested manually at the right time and selected with the utmost care for ripeness. This care gives the wines a very balanced and concentrated character.

Vinification

The grapes come from old vines. The quantity of grapes per hectare is limited and all grapes are harvested manually at the right time and carefully selected for maturity. This care gives the wines a very balanced and concentrated character. After a prefermentative maceration and the 5-day fermentation, the wine will mature for 12 months in barriques.

Taste

Ruby red color. Spicy in the nose with a hint of wild berries. Soft and round on the palate, with aromas of red jam and vanilla, this wine gives a warm and full feeling.
