Julius Klein – Rustenberg | Weinviertel Grüner Veltliner Austria – 2025

Domain

Julius Klein

The Klein family has been making wine since 1788. About 50 kilometers north of the Danube and Vienna lies the wine-growing region Weinviertel in the province of Nieder-Österreich. With 18,000 hectares of vineyards, this is also the largest wine-growing region in Austria.

Vinification

The vineyard with its Molasse soil contains vines of 45 years old. The grapes are hand-picked and bruised, followed by a maceration of half a day. After the pneumatic pressing, 10% whole grapes are added for fermentation. This is done in stainless steel tanks at 19 ° C. The bottles are then filled. 4.3 g / L residual sugar.

Taste

The color of the wine is clear golden yellow. The nose is tropical and intense, with pineapples and other southern fruits. On the palate, the wine is very elegant, with ripe and full-fruity aromas. The aftertaste is long and mineral.
