Julius Klein | Weinviertel Chardonnay Austria (WEINVIERTEL) — 2023

Domain

Julius Klein

The Klein family has been making wine since 1788. About 50 kilometers north of the Danube and Vienna lies the wine-growing region Weinviertel in the province of Nieder-Österrreich. With 18,000 hectares of vineyards, this is also the largest wine-growing region in Austria.

Vinification

Manual harvest, maceration for 8 hours on the skins and fermenation mainly with crushed grapes (90%) and some whole bunches (10%). The fermentation takes place in stainless steel vats (90%) and small barriques (10%).

Taste

Straw yellow color with golden reflections. Ripe white fruit (peach, pear, mango, apple). Delicate but medium bodied and creamy mouthfeel. Lingering acidity.
