## Julius Klein Weinviertel Chardonnay Austria — 2019

### Domain

#### Julius Klein

The Klein family has been making wine since 1788. About 50 kilometers north of the Danube and Vienna lies the wine-growing region Weinviertel in the province of Nieder-Österreich. With 18,000 hectares of vineyards, this is also the largest wine-growing region in Austria.

### Vinification

Manually picked grapes. 8 hours maceration, and 10% whole grapes are added to the fermentation. 90% is fermented in stainless steel barrels at 19 ° C, the remaining 10% on wood, in small barriques.

### Taste

This wine has a light yellow color with golden hues. We distinguish white and ripe fruit (peach, pear, mango, yellow apple) in the nose and mouth feeling. In the creamy final you can taste a delicate, pleasant acidity.
