Julius Klein - Cuvée Johannisberg | Weinviertel Austria (WEINVIERTEL) – 2022

Domain

Julius Klein

The Klein family has been making wine since 1788. About 50 kilometers north of the Danube and Vienna lies the wine-growing region Weinviertel in the province of Nieder-Österreich. With 18,000 hectares of vineyards, this is also the largest wine-growing region in Austria.

Vinification

Manually harvested grapes, the stalks of the grapes are removed, a temperature-controlled fermentation at 29 ° followed by an eight-day additional maceration. Malolactic fermentation started immediately after pressing. Ageing 11 months in large wooden barrels, then 18 months in small oak barrels. Residual sugar: 4g / L

Taste

The nose reveals ripe blackberry aromas, gently layered with hints of vanilla and chocolate. On the palate, it's a rich and rounded wine—elegantly spiced, with subtle roasted notes and smooth tannins that blend seamlessly into a fruity, well-balanced finish.
